Judge License Application

This application, upon its approval by the American Welara Pony Registry gives the applicant permission to judge equestrian related shows and events that are sanctioned, sponsored, or approved by the Welara Registry. If this application is approved, a Judges license and identification card will be issued to the applicant.

Before proceeding it is recommended for the applicant to carefully read the "Rules and Regulations" brochure and the "Showing the Welara" handbook, both are published and available from this Registry.

It is required for all applicants applying for a judge's license to be familiar with the rules and regulations set forth by USA Equestrian under their Welsh and Arabian divisions.

It is not mandatory for applicants to pay, or to be a member of USA Equestrian.

This Registry requires applicants to have a good working knowledge of the conformation and desirable traits for the Welsh, Arabian, and Welara breeds.

Judges are to base their decisions upon guidelines set forth by this Registry, USA Equestrian, and the respective breed registry of the particular breed that is to be judged. Personal preferences of equine breeds are not to influence a judge's decisions.

As a judge you may not perform judges duties at any show or event where an animal is to participate if there is any possible monetary interest whatever in any animal to be judged by you.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older, have a good reputation, and possess adequate health to perform their duties as a judge.

Judges are to be in good standing with this Registry, and must maintain membership with the American Welara Pony Registry at all times.

The applicant understands that rules and regulations are set forth by the American Welara Pony Registry at their discretion, and may be altered or changed at their discretion. Judges are required to keep informed of pertinent changes within the governing organizations of the equine breeds they are to judge.

Judges may not be under the influence of any alcoholic beverage whatever during their duties, nor any narcotic substance which in any way may alter, influence, or interfere with their judgment or performance. It is also stipulated that no judge shall perform in a manner that may be hazardous to the contestants, their animals, show ground officials, or any bystander / audience.

The applicant hereby agrees to judge all shows and events at which they are called to serve in a judge's capacity with honesty and integrity to the best of their ability.

It is further understood by the applicant that revoking or suspending a license of a judge licensed by the American Welara Pony Registry is at their discretion, and not by any other affiliated or non affiliated group. Such other groups may file a complaint against a judge with this Registry and such complaints will be studied and considered.

If such complaints are found to be valid this Registry may at its discretion subject the judge to a license suspension of six months to one year, at which time the judge will not be permitted to continue performing his / her duties at Welara Registry sanctioned, sponsored, or approved events. Judges may be called upon to furnish written examination as to their familiarity with current rules and regulations. And in the case of a complaint, this Registry will contact the judge in question requesting a written statement as to his / her description of the events surrounding the complaint.

If for any reason, or at any time, a judge continues to perform judging duties at a Welara Registry sanctioned, sponsored or approved equestrian event after his / her judge's license has been revoked or suspended, his / her judging decisions will not be recognized by this Registry nor will the show or event be recognized. The license of such an individual will at no time again be reinstated by this Registry. And the American Welara Pony Registry will report such behavior to other pertinent equine organizations at its discretion.

By signing this application the applicant agrees to uphold and to fully understand the rules, regulations, and duties described herein.
